If your passport expires soon (or you need to get a new one), you may want to send these applications sooner rather than later. Why? For starters, processing times are the shortest from September to December, according to the U.S. State Department. (Find out why they don't want you to go on vacation in these Mexican cities, though.) Demand for passports usually increases when the new year enters and continues into the summer. To quickly recover your passport, it is best to start your head now before the crazy rush of seasonal holidaymakers. Processing time aside, though, is another reason to make sure your passport is valid and the latest: The Real ID Act will take effect next year. This law sets certain standards for state driver's licenses to be considered valid federal IDs for use at airport security checkpoints. It goes without saying that not having a valid ID can cause a huge headache for airport security. To cover all your basics, you want to travel with your state license and your passport. In this way, if your license doesn't meet the requirements, you can simply rip out your valid passport – the problem is resolved. Make sure you avoid these airport errors before your next flight as well. To receive a new passport, you will need to arrive in person. Want to update? [Source: LA Times] A Canadian passport is internationally recognized proof of your Canadian citizenship, as well as the best possible photo identification. If you are traveling outside Canada, the Department of Foreign Affairs of the Federal Government of Canada recommends that you have a passport valid for at least six months after the expected date of return. Children, including newborns, cannot be included in their parents' passport and must hold their Canadian passport. A separate application for a passport must be submitted for each child. The standard adult passport is valid for 5 years as passports for children from 3 to 15 years old. Children under 3 years old are valid for a maximum of 3 years. Since passport applications take longer to process at peak times, Passport Canada suggests that you try to apply for your passport during the off-peak season from June to November. The Canadian passport application form contains different versions depending on the age and location where we apply, so be sure to use the right application form. Passport requirements may change, so when you make an application, pick up a new application form. You can pick up the Canadian passport application form in the participating Canadian in the opening Service Canada CentreAt Canadian Passport OfficeOnline forms are available in PDF format. They can be filled interactively online, then printed, signed and dated, and then submitted in person or by mail with accompanying documents, or they can be printed and filled out offline, then submitted. When using online forms, be sure to choose the right form and carefully follow the instructions for printing and filling out the form. Outside Canada, the Office of the Canadian Consulate. You must provide at least one document confirming your identity and name that will appear in your Canadian passport. This document must be issued by a federal, provincial or municipal government. It must be valid and contain your name and signature. A good example is the provincial driver's license. The original documents will be returned to you. If you provide photocopies, provide copies of both sides of the document. Your guarantor must sign and date all copies. A previous Canadian passport (not a photocopy) can be used as proof of identity if it is still valid or presented within one year of its expiry and the name is the same as that used in the current passport application. Additional documents may be required. You must provide the original proof of Canadian citizenship: If you were born inside Canada - either a birth certificate or a Canadian citizenship certificate. (See changes to the requirements of the birth certificate, which enter into force on 01 February 2011) If born outside Canada - a Certificate of Canadian Citizenship, a naturalization certificate, a Certificate of Preservation of Canadian Citizenship or a certificate of birth abroad. Add any valid Canadian passport. Expired passports need not be presented. If you have a current passport expiring more than 12 months after the date of the application, you will provide a written explanation as to why you applied earlier. You must also present any other travel document issued in the last five years. Get a photo of your passport and get two identical copies. Many photo processing stores and most photographers will make passport photos instantly and cheaply. Passport photos must be taken within 12 months of your application; within one month if the application is addressed to the child. Be sure to follow the specific standards that the passport office has set for acceptable photos. Passport Canada provides a handy checklist (PDF) that you can print and take with you when you go to the photographer. The photographer's name and address and the date of shooting must be indicated at the end of the passport photos. Your guarantor must write a declaration I confirm that this is a real (name) and I sign the end of one of the photos. All Canadian passport applications must be signed by the guarantor. The guarantor must also write a declaration I confirm that this is a real (name) and I sign the end of one of the passport photos, sign and date all copies of supporting documents. Your Canadian passport must be a person who has known you personally for at least two years and can confirm your identity and that your statements are accurate. Your guarantor must be a Canadian national who is 18 years of age or older and must hold a valid five-year Canadian passport or a Canadian passport with a period of validity of less than one year at the time you apply for a passport. The guarantor can be a member of your family. The guarantor must be available for passport canada verification purposes, and Passport Canada reserves the right to request another guarantor. The guarantor of your Canadian passport must be someone who has known you personally for at least two years and can confirm your identity and the fact that your statements are accurate. Your guarantor must reside in the jurisdiction of the passport issuing institution and must have a passport contact. Your guarantor must also be a member of one of the professions listed in the passport application form of one of the Canadians living abroad (e.g. a doctor or a practicing lawyer). You must also provide the names, addresses and phone numbers of two links that are neither your guarantor nor your relative. Links must be people who have known you for at least two years. Passport Canada may contact your links to confirm your identity. The application fees for your Canadian passport vary depending on the type of passport and where you apply. The passport application form will contain a processing fee. The methods of payment of processing fees also vary depending on whether you apply in Canada, the United States, or outside Canada and the United States. In Canada, you can pay a Canadian passport application fee in several ways: in cash or by debit card, if you submit an application form in person; a verified cheque or a money transfer payable to the Recipient of Canada; credit card. Canadian passport application fees for Canadians residing in the United States must be Canadian dollars. Fees may be paid by an approved cheque, a travel cheque or an international money transfer (by post or bank) paid to a Canadian recipient or by credit card. Canadian passport application fees must be paid in local currency to Canadians living abroad. Contact your local passport issuing service for the current exchange rate. Payments may be made in cash, an approved cheque, a travel cheque or an international money transfer (by post or bank) paid to the Embassy of Canada, the High Commission or the Consulate respectively. Make sure you have the correct passport application form. Read carefully the general information and instructions on the application form. Fill in all the necessary sections of the passport application form, otherwise your application will be rejected. Sign in the white box of Section 1 of the passport application form. Make sure that your signature does not touch the cell border. This signature will be used in your passport. Get The guarantor will sign section 2 of the passport application form, sign the end of one photograph and sign all photocopies of documents (both sides). Make sure that you sign and date all three pages of the passport application form. The application form must indicate the date within the last 12 months. Add all the documents and photos you need. Also include a valid passport and all travel documents issued in the last five years. Include the relevant passport application fee. Please apply again before submitting your application. Use the passport checklist to make sure your application is complete. If you submit your application in person, you must also take it personally. If possible, present your Canadian passport application in person. Canadian passport applications can be submitted in person to the Passport Canada officea participating in the Canadian Post Office (an additional fee will be charged) participating in the Services Canada Center of Canada Post Offices and Service Canada Centers only to handle standard passport applications. Canadian government offices in the United States and Bermuda do not provide regular passport services. Passport applications must be sent by post or courier to Canada. If you are outside Canada, the United States and Bermuda, your application must be submitted in person either by the institutions where you took the passport application form or to the nearest passport-issuing office in the country you are visiting. Passports are returned by an overnight courier service. The standard time for processing passport applications varies depending on where you apply, the time of year and the volume of applications. Passport Canada regularly updates the processing time (use the drop-down box at the top of the page to select your location) with the latest ratings. These ratings do not contain delivery time. Examining passport applications at peak times may take longer or if there are problems with the application. Off-peak passport applications in Canada are available between June and November. If your passport application has been longer than normal processing times, use the Passport Canada online form to verify the status of your Canadian passport application. Program.
